Community Center in City Park, 300 Parkview
Drive. They must be brought in Thursday,
September 26, from noon until 6 p.m.

Photographs entered must have on the back side
the name and phone number of the
photographer.

Photographs must have a hanging wire attached
to the backside

Judging of the photographs will be Friday
morning, September 27. Ribbons will be awarded
in Adult (18 and older) and Junior (0-17) divisions

Winners are eligible to have their images hung at
City Hall provided hanging specifications are met

The Show will be open to the public for viewing
Friday, September 27, from 2 p.m. – 4 p.m and
Saturday, September 28 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.



Photographs must remain at the Center until 4
p.m. Saturday, September 28. They must be
removed from the Center between 4 p.m. and 5
p.m. Saturday, September 28.

CATEGORIES FOR PHOTOGRAPHS AND DESCRIPTIONS OF EACH:

FLORAL: Flowers should be the main subject

PEOPLE: People or a single person should be a
part of the main subject

NATURE: Includes all living and non-living
elements of nature including insects, reptiles,
amphibians, fungus, rocks and plants other than
flowers.

SCENIC: Includes natural and unnatural scenic
elements such as waterfalls, landscapes,
cityscapes, rivers and beaches

ANIMALS: Includes all animals or mammals

BLACK AND WHITE: Photos should contain black
and white elements and printing

DIGITAL ART: Any photo that has had elements added or removed.

SUGARCANE INDUSTRY: Include any element of growing and celebrating Sugarcane
