



2015 SUGARCANE EXHIBIT RULES

ADULT DIVISION

The term producer as it applies in this class is defined as follows: A producer is the person or persons who actually produce the cane they are exhibiting on their own operational unit.

1. All exhibitors of sugarcane must be bonafide producers.
2. All exhibitors must have had five (5) or more acres of sugarcane on their farming operation in 2014.
3. A producer cannot enter more than one exhibit under the same class number.
4. A producer's exhibit will be disqualified if his/her sugarcane does not come from his/her own farming operation.

Three (3) stalks make an exhibit and you may enter an exhibit in as many classes as you wish.

JUNIOR DIVISION
