## Louisiana Sugarcane Festival Children's Parade

Saturday, September 23, 2023, 10:00 am

### **Rules that must be followed in the Children's Parade:**

1. No vulgar music, behavior, or dancing is allowed.
2. Appropriate attire is required at all times.
3. Throwing anything from the vehicles is not allowed.
  - a. Participants who wish to distribute items to the crowd must walk between the vehicle and the crowd and hand out those items.
4. All participating in the Saturday Children's Parade must be 14 years of age and younger.
5. A standard height truck must be used if pulling a float or participating in the Children's Parade
6. Horses are not allowed in the Saturday Children's Parade.
7. Any and all forms of ATVs are not allowed in the Saturday Children's Parade.

### **Start of Parade**

- The Saturday Children's Parade will begin at 10:00 am.
- All participants must be at their designated area before 8:30 am.
- All participants will be issued a lineup number.
  - A map of the lineup location is provided to help understand the layout.
- The start of the parade is located at the intersection of E. Main St. and Ann St.

### **End of Parade**

- The Saturday Children's Parade will travel down E. Main St. and will conclude at the intersection of Railroad Avenue.

## Louisiana Sugar Cane Festival Royalty Parade

Sunday, September 24, 2023 @ 12:00 pm

### **Commercial Vehicle Entry Requirements:**

1. All participating vehicles will be required to form a straight line on the right shoulder of Main St. starting at Lee St.
2. There is no official order for the commercial section. The lineup will be determined by whoever arrives first.
3. No vulgar music, behavior, or dancing is allowed.
4. Appropriate attire is required at all times.
5. Throwing anything from the vehicles is not allowed.
  - a. Participants who wish to distribute items to the crowd must walk between the vehicle and the crowd and hand out those items.
6. All participating in the Sunday Royalty Parade must be at least 14 years of age.
7. No alcohol is permitted on the vehicles or trailers during the parade.
8. Horses are not allowed in the Sunday Royalty Parade.
9. Any and all forms of ATVs are not allowed in the Sunday Royalty Parade.
- 10. All trailers must have railings installed on the sides and back.**

### **Cost to Participate in the Commercial Section of the Sunday Royalty Parade:**

- 18-wheelers - \$ 600.00
- Pickup Truck and Trailer - \$ 250.00
- Single Vehicle or Tractor - \$ 150.00
- Members of The Louisiana Sugar Cane Festival Board will be available to receive payment for entry into the parade and to answer any questions you may have. Those members will be able to accept cash or check.
