**NO Entries will be accepted after 9:00 am!!**

**Where:** Cyr Gates Community Center, New Iberia City Park

**Judging begins at 9:15 am** Friday, Sept. 26, 2025

Judging should be concluded by 12:00 pm (Noon). All Cookery winners will be presented with ribbons at their October 4-H Club meetings.

**Results will be posted at Cyr Gates Community Center after 2:30 pm on Friday, Sept 26.**

**General Cookery Rules** (Please call the 4-H Office at 337-369-4440 if you have specific questions).

- Participants must be Iberia 4-H members.
- **All entries must be made from scratch (no box mixes are to be used).**
- **All entries must contain one (1) cup or more of sugar in any form in the recipe.**
- **NO ENTRIES THAT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION CAN BE ENTERED. (Ex: Cheesecake, Ice Cream Cakes)**
- **NO raw eggs or cream cheese can be in the finished entry.**
- **Recipe must be taped on top of the entry.** (Recipe must include ingredients, amounts of each ingredient, directions, etc.) Failure to include the recipe can result in disqualification. On the backside of the recipe please include name, school, grade, and division.
- Each 4-H member can enter **only one** food entry in **each** division. 4-H'ers can enter as many divisions as they would like for a maximum of 12 entries.
- Pies can be fruit or nut based.
- To properly display your entries, place them on a **disposable/paper/plastic plate** and place plate **in a resealable, storage bag.**
- All entries will be destroyed after judging for food safety reasons. **NO entries will be returned, so please use disposable plates for your entries.**
- We are not responsible for exhibits that become lost, or damaged.
